Limited Warranty

During the time periods and subject to the conditions hereinafter set forth, Milwaukee Pump will repair or replace to the original user or consumer, any portion of your new Milwaukee Pump product which proves defective due to defective materials or workmanship of Milwaukee Pump. Contact your closest authorized Milwaukee Pump representative or distributor for warranty service. At all times, Milwaukee Pump shall have and possess the sole right and option to determine whether to repair or replace defective equipment, parts, or components. Damage caused by acts of GOD or conditions beyond the control of Milwaukee Pump is not covered by this warranty.

THIS WARRANTY WILL NOT APPLY:

- (1) To defects or malfunctions resulting from failure to properly install, operate, or maintain the product in accordance with printed instructions provided.
- (2) To failures resulting from abuse, accident, or negligence.
- (3) To normal maintenance services and the parts used in conjunction with such service.
- (4) To products which are not installed in accordance with applicable local area codes, ordinances, and good trade practices.
- (5) The product is used for purposes other than for what it was designed and manufactured.
- (6) If 3 phase motors are installed on a single phase power supply using a phase converter or if 3 phase power is supplied by only two transformers, making an open Delta system.

WARRANTY EXCLUSIONS:

Milwaukee Pump specifically disclaims the implied warranties of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose after the termination of the warranty period set forth herein. No warranties or representations at any time made by any representatives of Milwaukee Pump shall vary or expand the provision hereof.

LIABILITY LIMITATION:

In no event shall Milwaukee Pump be liable or responsible for consequential, incidental, or special damages resulting from or related in any manner to any Milwaukee Pump product or parts thereof. Personal injury and/or property damage may result from improper installation. Milwaukee Pump disclaims all liability, including liability under this warranty, for improper installation. Milwaukee Pump recommends following the instructions in the installation manual. When in doubt, consult a professional. Some states do not allow the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages, so the above limitation or exclusion may not apply to you.

LABOR, ETC, COSTS:

Milwaukee Pump shall in no event be responsible or liable for the cost of field labor or other charges incurred by any customer in removing and/or re-affixing any Milwaukee Pump product, part, or component thereof.

RETURNED OR REPLACED COMPONENTS:

Any item to be replaced under this Warranty must be returned to Milwaukee Pump, or such other place as Milwaukee Pump may designate, freight prepaid.
